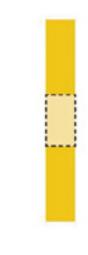

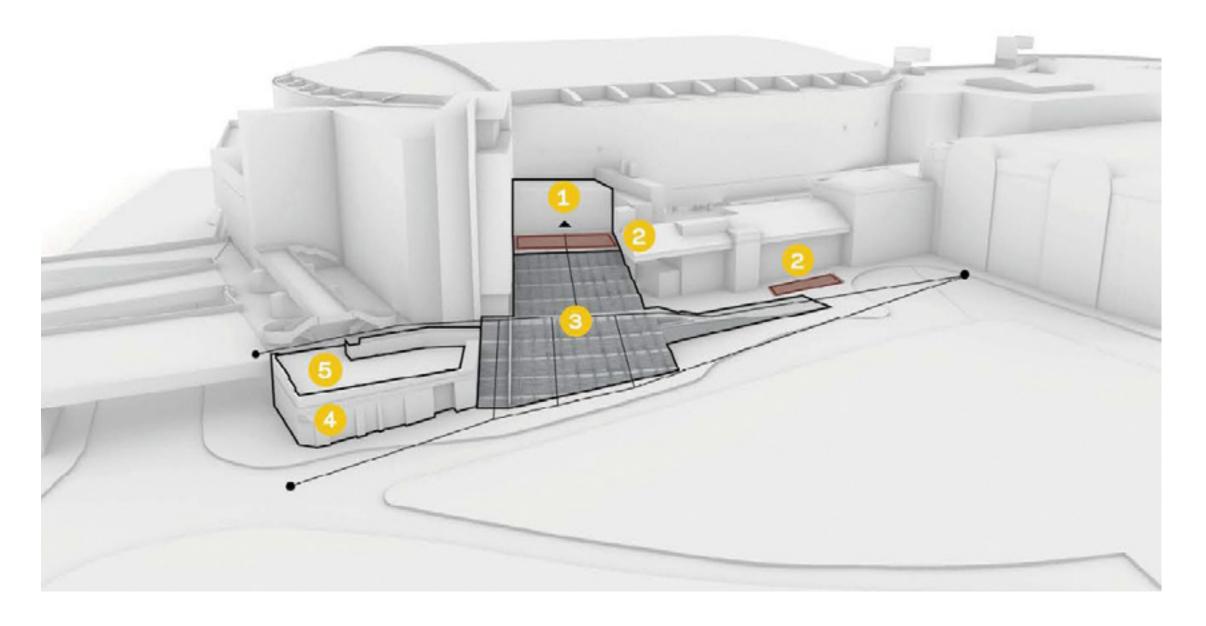
#### PHASE 1 WORKS

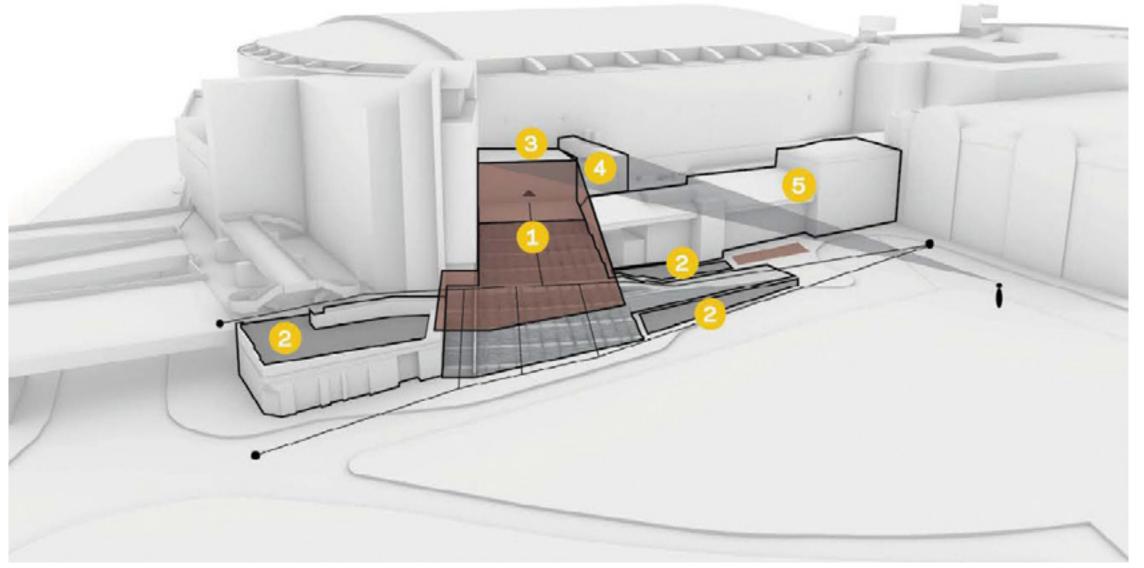
- Predominantly relate to the existing Hunts Bank entrance steps, which have a number of operational and aesthetic challenges, and the plans propose the introduction of a ramp will allow a better and more visible entrance from Victoria Station, greater control of routes into the Arena, be more inclusive, offer an enhanced security checkpoint, and provide shelter for people queuing.
- The proposals will also allow for the provision of a community / retail space beneath the ramp where discussions are progressing to provide a music therapy centre for the leading music industry charity Nordoff Robbins.
- These proposals, alongside changes to the Trinity Way entrance / exit, will help facilitate a number of the significant internal changes that will allow the customer experience and standing capacity to be greatly enhanced.

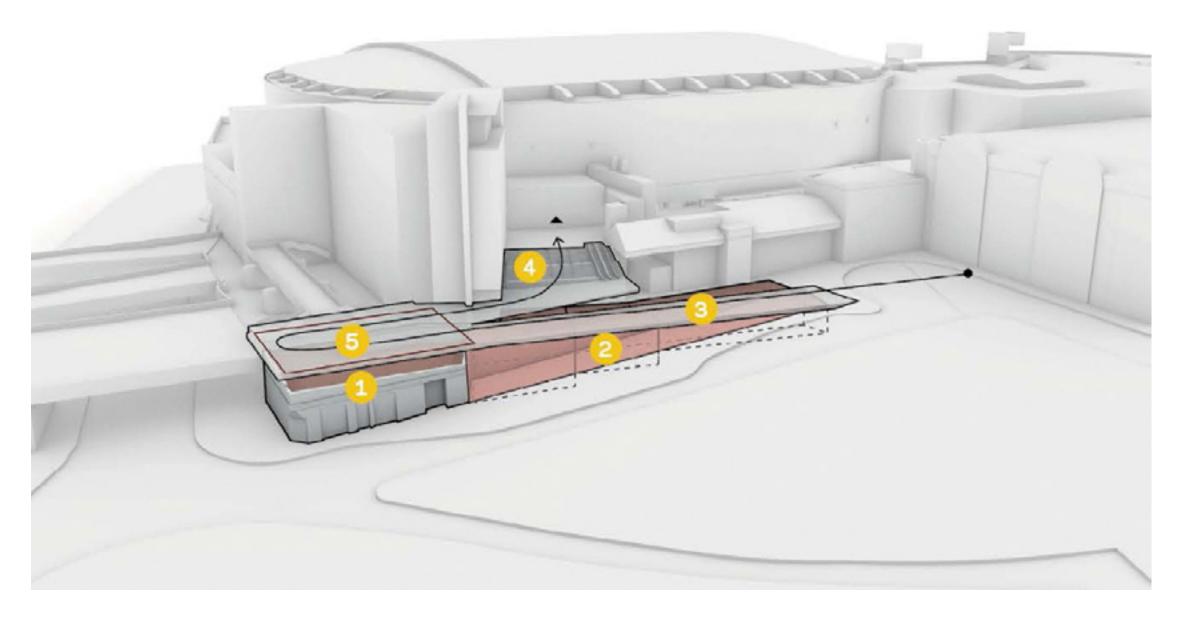

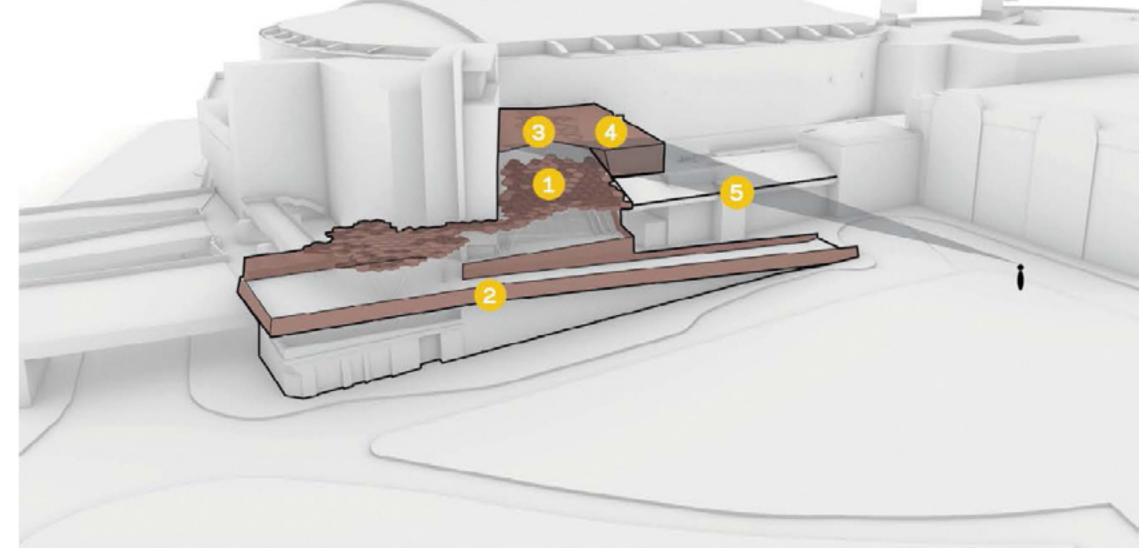
